ZEBRA MUSSELS

Luckily, so far, none have been reported in Lake Kennebec. To keep it this way, please thoroughly clean your boats as you bring them from other water bodies to Kennebec. Flushing with chlorine appears to be the best method so far. To test for mussels, suspend a string with a heavy weight somewhere near your dock. If there are any zebra mussels, they will adhere.
